Our Father in Heaven, hallowed be your name.



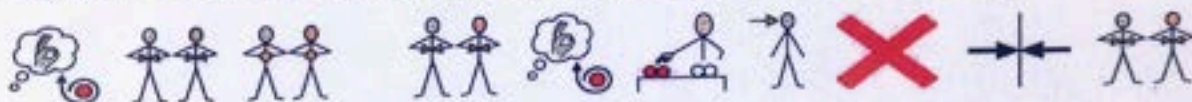
Your kingdom come, your will be done,

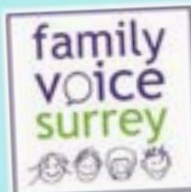
