Thank you, Cranleigh School!



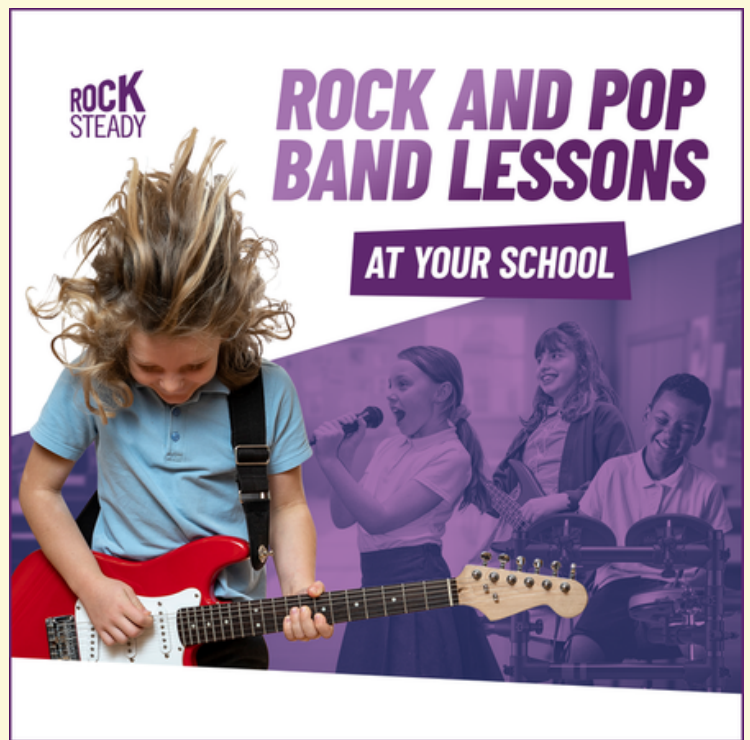

Upper KS2 News

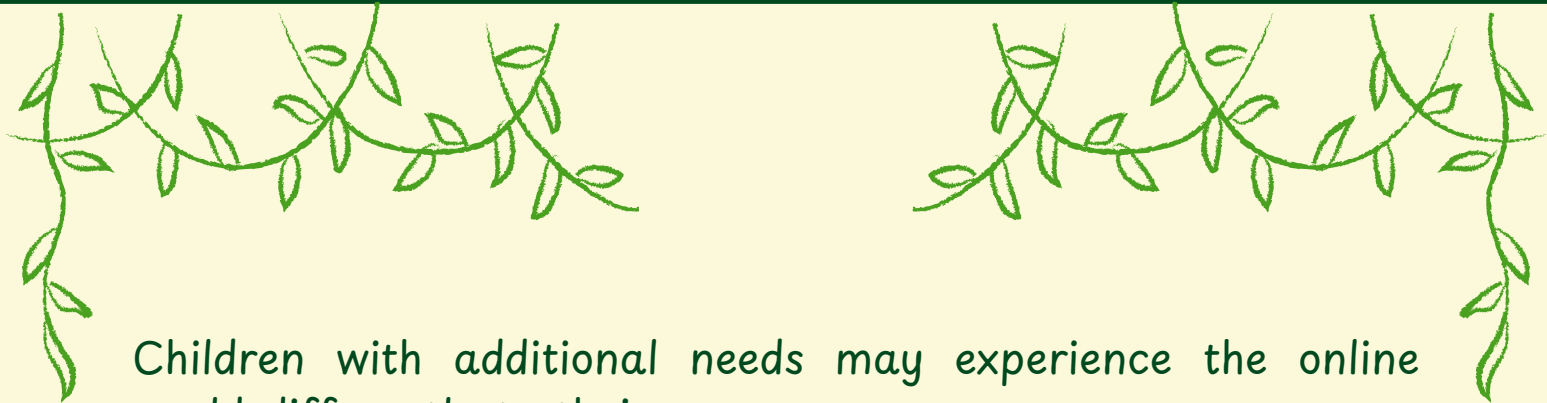

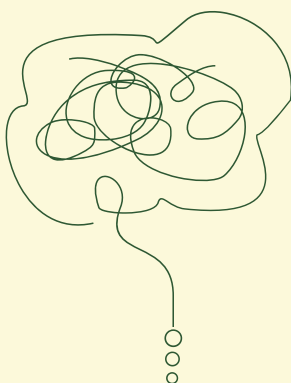
Children with additional needs may experience the online world differently to their peers.
