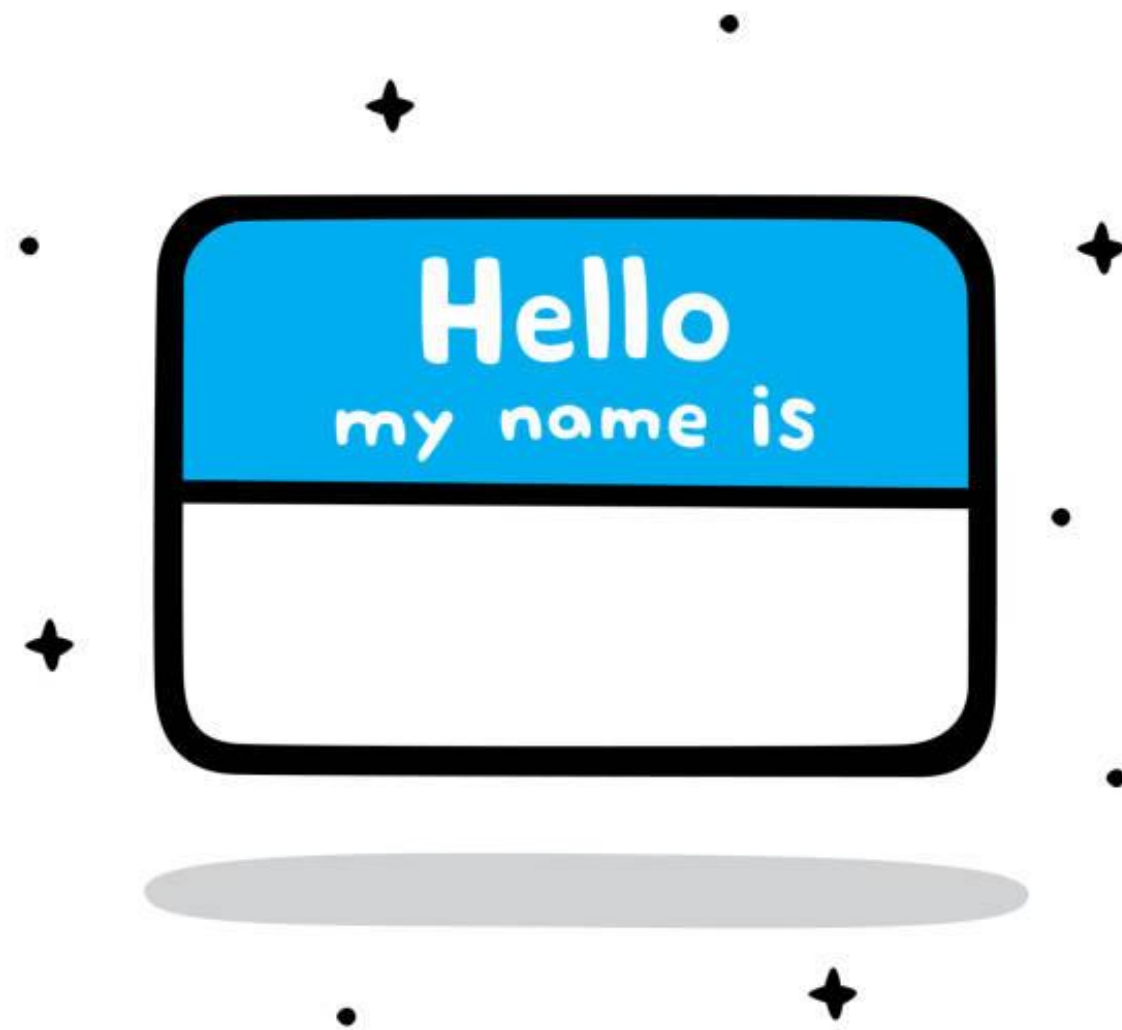
Home learning

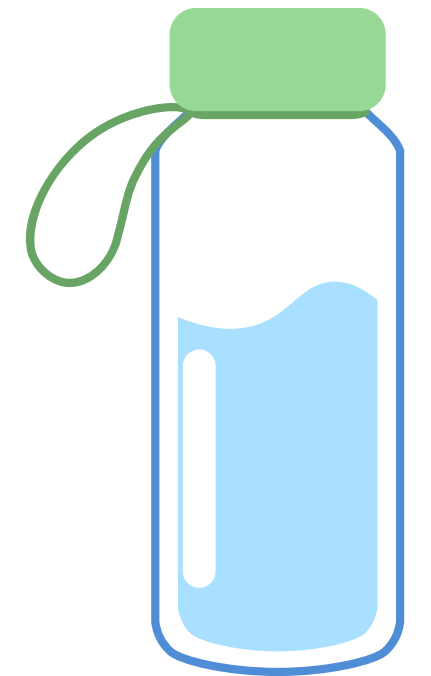

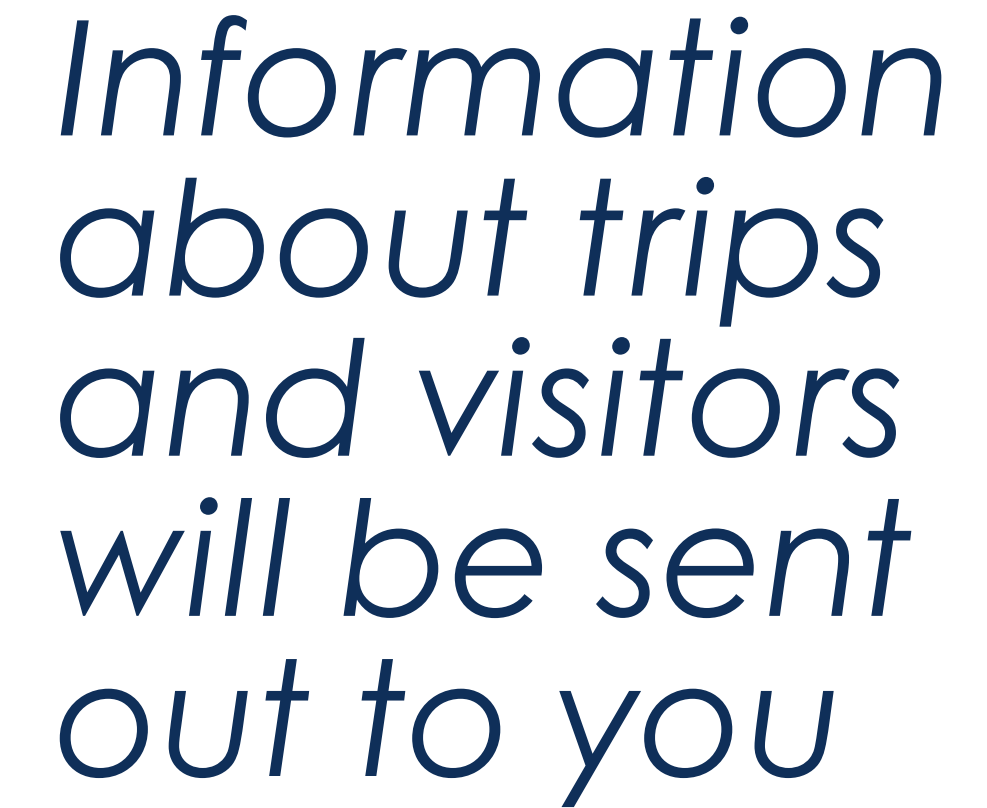

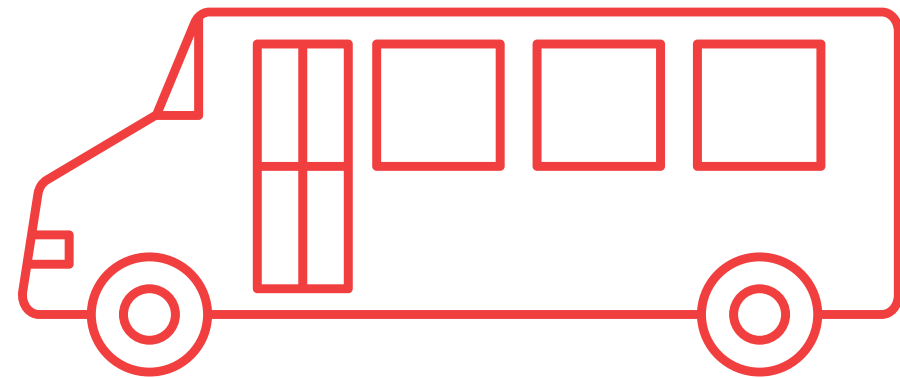
