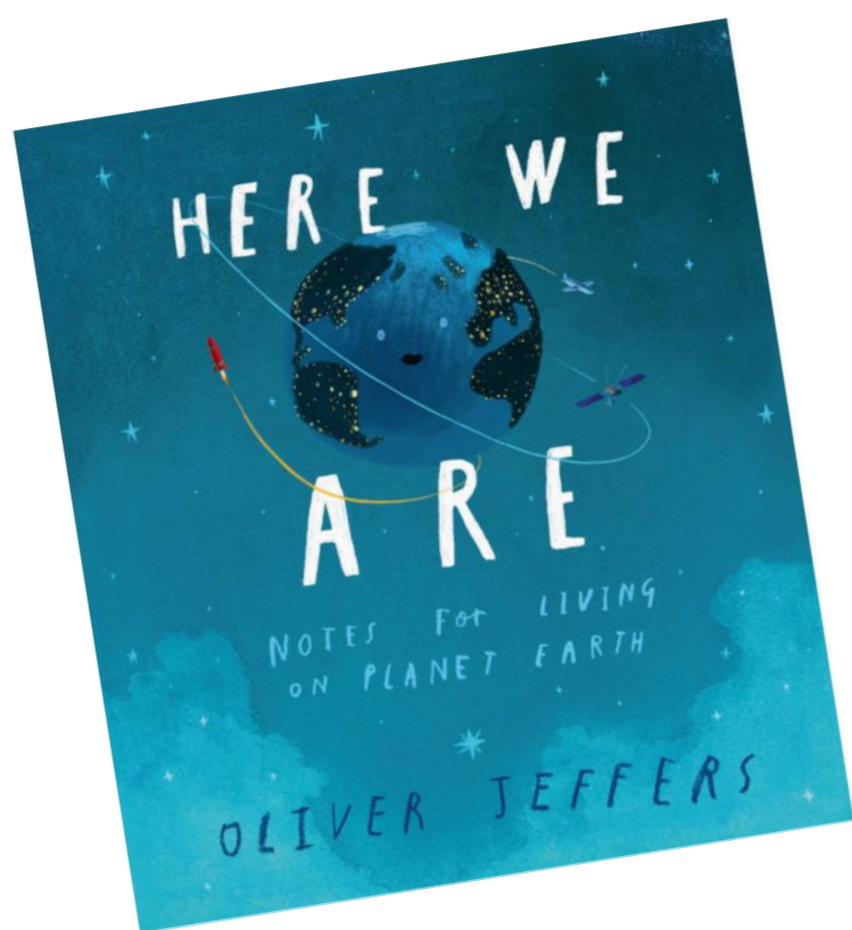

EYFS and Key Stage 1 News

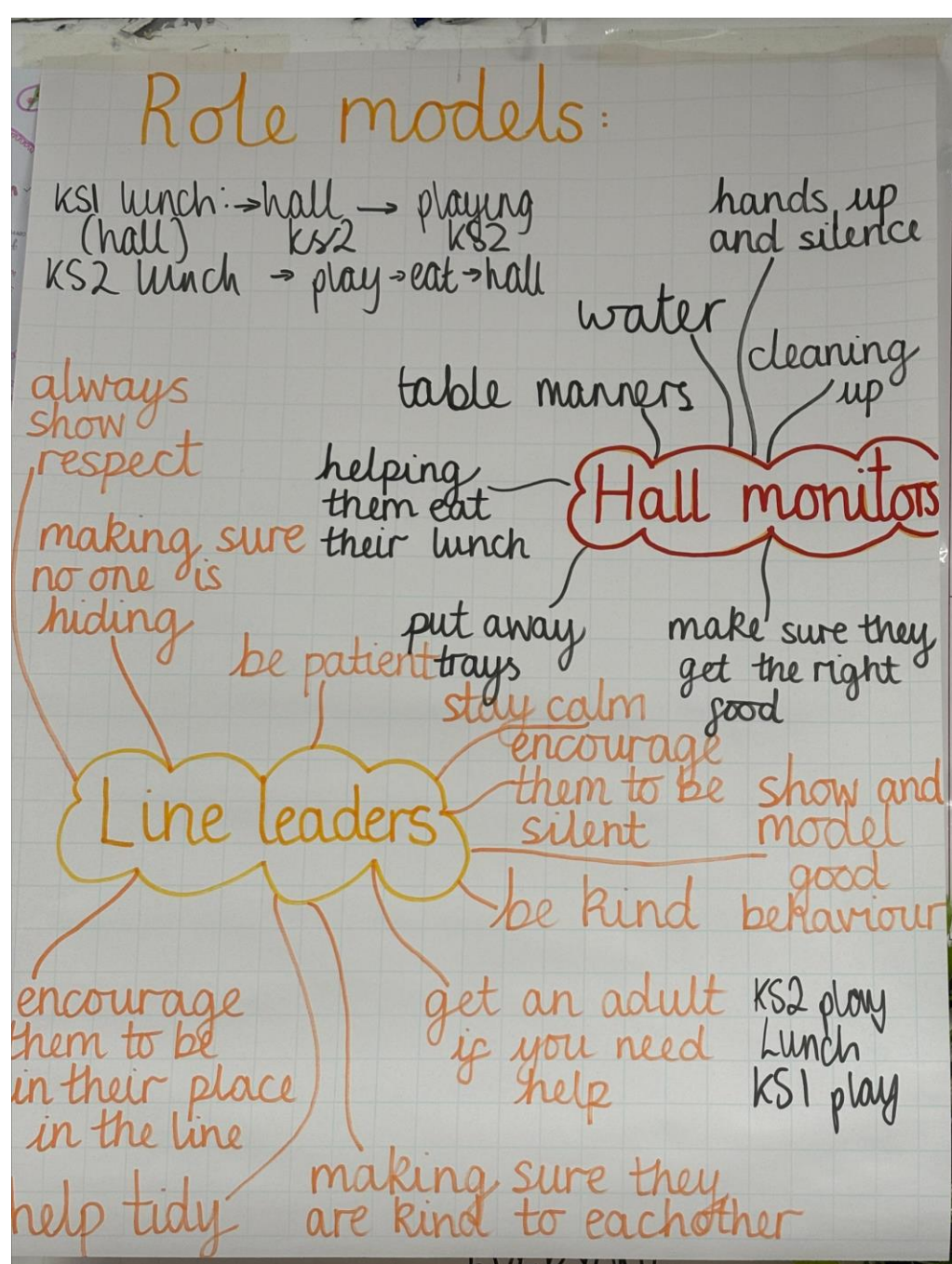
In EYFS we have been practicing singing our Christmas songs! Fa la la la! You might enjoy hearing them being practised at home!
