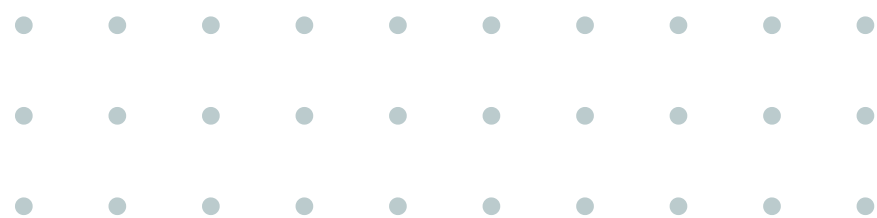

# Times Tables

The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) is a statutory assessment for Key Stage 2 pupils, taken in June of Year 4.

In class, we are using the Number Sense Tables Fluency programme to learn 36 key multiplication facts.

It is essential that pupils practise their times tables on **TT Rock Stars** at least once a week, so their progress can be tracked and supported effectively.

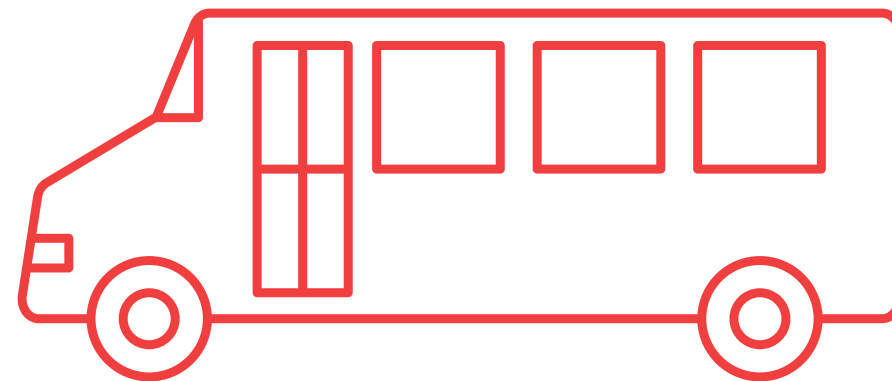
